ABOUT THE LODGE AT BRYCE CANYON: A National Historic Landmark, The Lodge at Bryce Canyon is the only lodge of that era to remain largely intact. The decor and atmosphere maintains that authenticity while tending to guest's comfort and needs.

The Lodge is ideally located nearby the canyon's rim and hiking trailheads. Guests are only steps away from scenic viewpoints, fine dining, shopping, and park programs.

ABOUT BRYCE CANYON

Bryce Canyon is unique in that it is not a "real canyon" carved by flowing water, but rather a giant natural amphitheater created by erosion along the eastern side of the Paunsaugunt Plateau. Bryce Amphitheater, which is 12 miles long, three miles wide and 800 feet deep, is the largest of all the amphitheaters in the park. Water is the active ingredient here, but in the form of "frost-wedging" and chemical weathering.

For two hundred days a year the temperature goes above and below freezing every day. During the day, melt water seeps into fractures only to freeze at night, expanding by nine percent. Now as ice, it exerts a tremendous force (2,000-20,000 pounds per square inch). Over time this "frost-wedging" shatters and pries rock apart. In addition, rain water, which is naturally acidic, slowly dissolves the limestone, rounding off edges and washing away debris.

Sunset Point and Sunrise Point Rooms

- Positioned just steps from the rim
- Appointed with cozy-lodge style furnishings reproduced from original Arts & Crafts-era pieces used in the lodge
- Either a king or two queen beds (cribs and rollaways may be added for a small fee)
- Accommodates up to five guests in queen rooms, three in king rooms
- Full bathroom (shower/tub) with sink/dressing area and hair dryer
- Semi-private porch or balcony
- Refrigerator, microwave, coffee maker, alarm clock, telephone, portable fan and thermostat-controlled heat
- ADA accessible rooms available

Guest Suites

- Located in the main lodge on the second floor, accessible by two flights of stairs; no elevators are available but a porter is always on duty to assist guests with bags.
- One queen bed
- Full bath
- Coffee maker, alarm clock, telephone and portable fan

Guest Studio

- One queen bed
- Full bath
- Coffee maker, alarm clock, telephone and portable fan

Western Cabins

- Include gas log fireplace and rustic features such as open beams and lodge-pole-pine walls.
- Organized in groups of two or four with a connecting door if desired.
- Two queen beds
- Full bathroom
- Additional sink/dressing area with hair dryer
- Small semi-private porch
- Coffee maker, alarm clock, telephone, portable fan, thermostat-controlled heat

In keeping with the park's desire to maintain its uniquely tranquil setting, rooms do not have televisions, WiFi or air conditioning. Free WiFi is available in the main lodge.
