ABOUT RAIL EXPLORERS USA:

Just 20 minutes from the Las Vegas Strip is an exhilarating four-mile downhill ride where guests can experience the beauty of the Nevada desert, the River Mountains and the Eldorado Valley on a 1.5-hour scenic journey through Boulder City, Nevada. Adventurers of all ages ride the historic rails on custom-built bikes from Nevada State Railroad Museum four miles downhill to Railroad Pass, before boarding the historic train for a nostalgic ride back to the museum.

TOURS:

- **SOUTHWEST RAMBLE**
A four-mile downhill pedal-powered daytime ride.
- **SUNSET TOUR**
A picturesque downhill ride in the evening as the sun sets behind the River Mountains.
- **EVENING LANTERN RIDE**
A one-of-a-kind experience illuminated by the glow from the moon and stars.

All rides start at the Nevada State Railroad Museum and continue downhill to Railroad Pass. Each tour also includes a nostalgic ride back to the top of the hill in one of the museum's historic trains, along with free museum entry.

AGE REQUIREMENT:

Rail Explorers is an all-ages activity! Children must be accompanied by a rider at least 16 years of age to operate the brakes. Groups of children can ride on their own explorer, provided it is coupled to an adult's explorer.

For safety, all riders must be secured in their own seat. The only exception is infants, who must be secured in a chest harness to an adult rider. Infants in a chest harness travel free. Younger children may not be able to reach the pedals but can be safely buckled in to enjoy the ride. Toddler harnesses are available for additional security.

Rail Explorer rail bikes have four steel wheels, hydraulic disc brakes, pedals for each seat and are comfortable, fun and easy to ride for guests of any age or ability. Although rail bikes require pedaling, the magic of steel wheels on steel rails makes the experience distinctive from riding a regular bicycle.
