



## FACT SHEET: FIREARMS TRAINING SIMULATOR

<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	Created to focus on methods used to apprehend and prosecute criminals and their organizations, the Firearms Training Simulator represents one of the Museum's newest, experiential exhibitions. It places guests in the shoes of law enforcement officers, where they engage in an intensive training session using both digital and live role-playing scenarios demonstrating the speed and complexity surrounding use of force decisions. Related exhibits examine an array of factors that influence law enforcement responses to real or perceived threats, with a focus on the use of deadly force.
