





FACT SHEET: CRIME LAB EXPERIENCE

DESCRIPTION:

Designed in the spirit of a science center discovery room, the Crime Lab offers guests a hands-on, multimedia exploration of five different forensic science techniques used to prosecute criminals. Guests can choose the order in which they explore the Crime Lab during the 30-minute facilitated experience, which is guided by a Museum educator. While spending time at each station, guests will acquire a foundational understanding of death investigation, DNA extraction and profiling, fingerprint analysis, crime scene investigation and firearms examination.

HANDS-ON FORENSIC SCIENCE STATIONS:

- Death investigation features a touch table on which guests will learn about the work of forensic pathologists. They will examine a representation of a deceased individual to determine the cause and manner of death. Three different death investigation scenarios are presented at this station, each one drawn from a real-life organized crime figure's death.
- DNA profiling is the process of comparing DNA samples to determine if there's a match. This interactive illustrates how DNA is physically extracted from crime scene evidence and matched with a suspect.







- At the fingerprint analysis station, guests have their fingerprints taken with a digital scanner and then they determine what kind of fingerprints they have. They learn how fingerprints are recovered from a crime scene and what fingerprint analysts are looking for to determine an accurate match.
- Crime scene investigation describes different types of evidence that can be found at a crime scene. A moving magnifying glass allows guests to take a close look at what crime scene analysts find.
- At the firearms examination station, guests use a comparison microscope to compare marks on fired bullets to find matches. This station also has an artifact case featuring tools of the forensic trade.
